



TOWN OF GLENROCK TREE GRANT INFORMATION

Tree Grant Policy:

1. Grant applications must meet the following criteria:
 - (a) Trees must be adjacent to a public right-of-way or pose an immediate threat to any structure or neighboring property as determined by a certified arborist.
 - (b) May be used for business or residential property.
 - (c) Must be approved by Council prior to removal.
2. Tree trimming or removal must be performed by a licensed contractor.
3. Applicant must submit two (2) contractor bids for the proposed improvement(s). Grant funds will be calculated at 50% of the lowest bid not to exceed \$500 for the total job estimate; however, the applicant is not obligated to contract with the lowest bidder.
4. Funds will be disbursed on a first come, first serve basis, upon receipt of a paid in full invoice and will be awarded until all funds have been expended.
5. Each residence may apply for a grant once a fiscal year.

Mayor, Council Members & Town Employees
are not eligible for this grant opportunity.
